The services provided at our clinic focus on Pet Overpopulation and Disease Prevention.

Appointment and proof of rabies vaccination required, or purchase vaccine day of surgery.

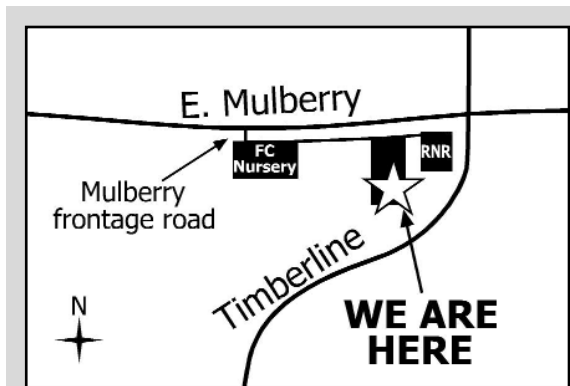

About the SHELTER

Our cats come to us from many situations:

- Found abandoned or as strays
- Surrendered by their owners
- Transferred from other shelters

— Adoption Fees —

- Normal Adoption Fee is \$50 for adult cats and kittens
- Monthly Featured Felines for \$10
 - 2-for-1 Mama & Me specials (Adopt a kitten and take home mama for free!)
 - \$10 Seniors for Seniors (Age 55 and older, adopt a cat that is 8 years or older for only \$10)

All adoptable cats/kittens have had:

- ✓ Veterinary exam
- ✓ Spay/neuter procedure
- ✓ Appropriate testing
- ✓ Deworming
- ✓ Vaccinations
- ✓ Microchip identification

Adopter also receives a coupon for a FREE local veterinary exam and a small bag of Natural Balance cat food.

— Other Programs —

We've established the following programs to increase the number of animals helped in our community:

- Foster Program for kittens and special needs cats
- Cat and dog food assistance for low-income families
- Rental of live traps for feral cat Trap/Neuter/Return

Kibble Supply

Food Bank for Low-Income Pet Owners

Pet owners experiencing financial hardship and having difficulty affording dog or cat food can pick up free food every 2 weeks, as needed.

Purrfect Therapy

Trained & Certified Therapy Cat

Our registered therapy cat, Jake, visits with seniors in nursing homes and with families who have been the victims of domestic violence to promote emotional and physical improvement.

Humane Education

Teaching Kindness to Animals

We welcome field trips to visit the cat shelter and gladly accept invitations to classrooms. Our therapy cat, Jake, can visit and help teach children the importance of kindness to animals.

PAL+

Financial Assistance for Spay/Neuter, Vaccines & Microchipping

The Prevent A Litter Plus (PAL+) program assists individuals who cannot afford to spay, neuter, vaccinate or microchip their pets. PAL+ provides these services free of charge to approved low-income applicants or those receiving government assistance. This program is made possible through monetary donations and grants, so financial assistance is dependent upon availability of funding.
