## Price List for DOG Surgery

### Females\*

Spay up to 30 lbs.	\$70
Spay 31-59 lbs.	\$75
Spay 60-90 lbs.	\$85
Spay over 90 lbs.	\$95

### Males

Neuter up to 30 lbs.	\$70
Neuter 31-59 lbs.	\$75
Neuter 60-90 lbs.	\$80
Neuter over 90 lbs.	\$85
If Cryptorchid, add'l	\$20-\$100**
Pain Medication	\$7

\*All spays include local pain block.

\*\*If either or both testicles have not dropped into the scrotum. Price depends on difficulty of surgery.

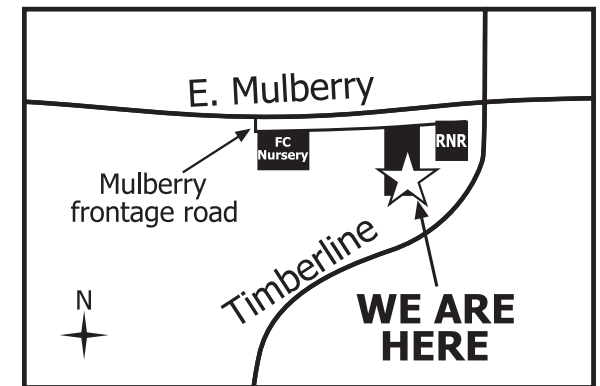
