



Foster Contract

This contract is between the Fort Collins Cat Rescue and _____.
The person listed above is considered the foster provider, and agrees to the following foster provisions and guidelines:

1. The animal(s) in foster care, and any kittens born to the animal in foster care, are the sole property of the Fort Collins Cat Rescue.
2. If the foster provider would like to adopt any of the animals in foster, they shall immediately inform the Fort Collins Cat Rescue. All routine paperwork in regards to adoption, and adoption fees will be required.
3. The Fort Collins Cat Rescue reserves the right to remove the animal from the foster provider at any time.
4. Fort Collins Cat Rescue will provide all of the food, litter, and supplies necessary to properly foster the cat(s)/kitten(s).
5. The foster provider will pick up all food, litter, and supplies needed from Fort Collins Cat Rescue. The foster provider will transport the foster animals to / from the shelter as needed for appointments & adoptions.
6. Should the foster provider purchase any supplies from a store without talking to a FCCR representative, they will not be refunded for the money spent. If the foster provider speaks to a FCCR representative and they okay supplies being bought from a store, with presentation of a receipt the foster provider will be refunded.
7. Any cats or kittens in the care of the foster provider will have access at all times to the appropriate food, water, bedding and shelter.
8. FCCR may make recommendations concerning how to work with foster animals on a daily basis (including quarantine, training, etc). These things are under the foster providers control and not FCCRs direct control, therefore the foster provider takes full responsibility for any damage the foster animals do to living areas, pets, belongings, or to persons the foster animals may come in contact with.
9. If at any time one of the animals in foster gets sick or does not seem normal, the foster provider shall immediately contact the shelter – (970) 484-8516. If it is outside of normal hours and the foster provider feels it is an emergency or cannot wait, they should contact emergency only staff phone numbers (Mary, Gloria and Sarah).

10. If any foster animal is injured while in foster care, and the injury is caused from an owned animal in the home or negligence from the foster care provider, the foster care provider will take full responsibility of payment on any medical costs incurred in treating the foster animal.
11. Any decisions for the animal(s) in foster care, in regards to medical or behavioral issues, are to be made only by the Fort Collins Cat Rescue staff, or a veterinarian.
12. The animal(s) in foster are not to be taken anywhere outside of the foster home, or to be transferred anywhere without the approval of a Fort Collins Cat Rescue staff member.
13. The foster animals are to be kept indoors only and should not be allowed to go outside even if they are supervised. This is because all of our kitties are adopted out as indoor only animals so we do not want them begging to get out or becoming exposed to dangerous things outside. If foster animals are going to be exposed to owned cats in the home, the owned cats must be indoors only and recently tested for FeLV.

The foster provider shall read and initial the following statements. By initialing they agree and understand the following statements:

1. I agree to all of the above foster provisions and guidelines. _____
2. I understand that there are risks both to myself, my property and any pets I may have in my home by fostering animals. _____
3. I understand that the Fort Collins Cat Rescue cannot guarantee the health of any of the animals I may take home to foster. _____
